TJHSST Summer School will run from July 8 – August 7, 2008.

No transportation or lunch services will be provided.

General Information

Two different types of courses will be offered during the TJHSST Summer Programs 2008: academic courses for credit (TJ Summer School) and the Summer Technology Institute courses.
